

Dear Members,

As we enter what is typically opening weekend for the HCC Pool Facility, we would like to wish you a safe and happy Memorial Day Weekend. We would also like to take this opportunity to give the membership an update on where we currently stand.

We continue to accept Pool Members, however, the current guidelines in place from the State of Massachusetts would put the earliest possible opening date for the pool at June 15th. This is based on the best-case scenario of Phase 2 for the Massachusetts Opening Phase Plan.

Our preparation for the pool season has remained intact as if we were opening on time, and we will use the additional time to continue to work on as many projects and upgrades as we can. As soon as we are given the green light, we will be ready to kick off the 2020 Pool Season. The current state and federal guidelines are still vague, but rest assured we will be vigilant in maintaining a close watch and following any and all safety procedures and protocols.

It goes without saying that we will be working around the clock to make sure that all areas of our pool facility are regularly cleaned and sanitized. The following are ***potential*** restrictions we could be faced with for the 2020 season:

- Reduced capacity throughout the pool facility, including, the pools & deck, locker rooms, and snack bar area as we meet social-distancing guidelines
- Limited availability of lounges, seating areas, and cabanas to meet CDC guidelines
- Limited/Restricted swim team and competitive swimming events
- Limited/Restricted guest policy
- Private or semi-private swimming lessons only
- No swing set/playground access

Please be aware that June 15th is the earliest potential opening day for the pool facility. In the event that Phase 2 is further extended, our Board of Governors will explore dues pro-rations. Should the delay of Phase 2 completely impede upon the 2020 Pool Season we will be refunding any pool dues paid.

Any potential restrictions implemented for the 2020 season will be for the safety of both our pool members and staff. Our goal is to still provide a fun, safe recreational escape for you and your family to enjoy this summer.
